Keeping our clients, employees and the community safe is our top priority. With this in mind, we want to share the steps Inland Respite, Inc. will be taking in response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). Based on the recommendations of the CDC and other Health Officials, we will temporarily cease operations including in-home respite services beginning **Friday, March 23, 2020** with an anticipated return date of **Monday April 6, 2020**. This temporary suspension of services applies to both Routine and Preferred Provider Programs.

Higher-level Executives and Department Managers will be working remotely during the closure. Our agency is committed to seamlessly provide the support that our specific community depends from us.

Inland Respite, Inc. recognizes that this decision could pose significant challenges and hardship to many families and Respite Care Providers; however, this decision has been made in effort to slow and disrupt the transmission of this pandemic disease within our community and prevent spread to our vulnerable consumers. We will continue to monitor and reassess during this time whether a closure/care suspension extension is warranted.
